

FIFTY PERCENT RULE & THE MPP

As of Fall Quarter 2005, all graduate students including MPP students must have at least 50 percent of their coursework in “stand alone” graduate credits (i.e., not “slash” classes with undergraduates in attendance). The typical MPP student will be in compliance with the following schedule:

For “in-service” students (already employed and therefore not needing an internship), careful selection of electives will have to be taken to comply with this rule.
