## INTRODUCTION

Westslope cutthroat trout (*Oncorhynchus clarki lewisi*) populations in the John Day basin, Oregon, are widely separated from the larger, contiguous distribution in the upper Missouri and Columbia basins of Montana and Idaho. Other disjunct populations occur on the eastslope of the Washington Cascades in the Mid-Columbia region (Behnke 1992). Three theories exist regarding the origin of these disjunct populations. One theory suggests these cutthroat trout populations were dispersed through the Mid-Columbia Basin by repeated flooding of glacial Lake Missoula during the late-Pleistocene (Behnke 1992). However, there is no paleontological evidence of fish in Lake Missoula (Cameron Sharp, WDFW, personal communication). A second and contrary theory suggests the distribution of westslope cutthroat trout, and other trout species, resembles a pattern of extinction rather than dispersal. In other words, westslope cutthroat trout, initially present throughout the region, were wiped out by the Lake Missoula floods. Populations existing in protected basins, such as the John Day River, persisted through the floods. (Dr. Doug Markle, OSU, personal communication). The third theory suggests westslope cutthroat trout are non-native in Oregon and were introduced into the John Day Basin through human stocking and transfer events. The goal of this study was to address the latter theory by examining the stocking history of trout in the upper John Day basin.

In addition to cutthroat trout, the stocking history of rainbow trout and cutthroat trout subspecies is presented to address links between stocking of non-native species and their hybridization with westslope cutthroat trout. Hybridization with rainbow trout and other cutthroat trout subspecies poses a significant genetic risk to westslope cutthroat trout throughout their range (Lee 1997). Where non-native hatchery stocked rainbow trout are sympatric with westslope cutthroat trout, hybridization is common (McIntyre and Reiman 1995). Similarly, hybridization between Yellowstone cutthroat and westslope cutthroat trout is widespread where the two species co-occur. Yellowstone cutthroat trout were routinely introduced throughout the West in the early part of the 1900's to provide angling opportunities.

The historical stocking records identify potential events where westslope cutthroat trout were introduced into the basin and may address questions of origin. This investigation complements a concurrent study of westslope cutthroat trout genetics in Oregon. The stocking history of other cutthroat trout subspecies and rainbow trout will provide background for understanding hybridization that is identified during collection and analysis of genetic data. The investigation is limited to the North Fork John Day River and the upper mainstem John Day River basins where westslope cutthroat trout are present. A particular effort was made to located information from the late 1800's and early 1900's.

## DISTRIBUTION OF WESTSLOPE CUTTHROAT TROUT

The distribution of westslope cutthroat trout in the John Day Basin is limited to the North Fork and upper mainstem tributaries. The presence of westslope cutthroat trout has not been detected in the Middle Fork or South Fork John Day River. In the North Fork John Day Basin westslope cutthroat trout are restricted to the South Fork Desolation, Lake Creek subbasin, and Clear Creek subbasin. Westslope cutthroat trout are widely distributed in the

upper mainstem reaches of the John Day River. They occupy 1) Fields Creek and tributaries; 2) Moon Creek; 3) McClellan Creek; 4) Ingle Creek; 5) Laycock Creek; 6) Canyon Creek and tributaries; 7) Little Pine Creek; 8) Dog Creek; 9) Pine Creek; 10) Indian Creek and tributaries; 11) Strawberry Creek and tributaries; 12) Upper John Day River and tributaries (including major tributaries: Graham, Call, Roberts, Reynolds, Deardorff, and Rail creeks); 13) Dixie Creek and tributary; 14) Bear Creek; 15) Beech Creek and tributaries; 16) Birch Creek; and 17) Belshaw Creek (Knapp and Unterwegner 2001).

## **METHODS AND SOURCES**

Historical stocking records maintained by the State of Oregon were the primary sources of information for this report. In addition, I interviewed long-time landowners in the John Day Basin as well as retired basin biologists, and investigated records from federal hatcheries known to raise cutthroat trout in the early 1900's. All stocking events were compiled into an electronic database (appendix A).

### ODFW & Fish Commission stocking records

- 1) Oregon State Game Commission Fish Liberation Reports, 1956-1973 – Main-frame computer reports generated from original liberation tickets which includes lot numbers, hatchery, liberation dates, and size information. Liberation reports pre-1956 and post-1973 were missing. The liberation tickets on which these reports were based were permanently lost to fire. (lib rpt)
- 2) Cumulative Stocking Records from the Oregon State Game Commission, 1948-1957 - Stocking records summarized by date, year and watershed; records include lot numbers, hatchery, liberation dates, and size information. (cum rec)
- 3) ODFW Hatchery Management Information System Database, 1979-Present - current ODFW fish liberation database. (HMIS)
- 4) Liberation Cards, 1925-1934 – annual summary of liberation events. Each card represented an individual stream for which the total number of fish per species per year was recorded. The origin of these cards is unknown. (cards)
- 5) Dan Bottom's Research – In 1991-92, Dan Bottom, a research biologist at ODFW, collected all stocking records of trout for Eastern Oregon. Bottom's records were compared with the above sources for quality control purposes and in many cases, particularly in the 1940's and 1970's, were used where original records could not be located. Bottom apparently was able to locate Fish Liberation Reports prior to 1956. (D.B.)
- 6) Stocking of Trout and Salmon by Watershed, 1947-1977 by R.O. Koski - Annual summaries of stocking activity for each stream. Each record describes the total number of fish stocked per stream each year and does not include hatchery or origin information. A combined report, Fish Liberation by Watershed 1948-1957, was the primary source for years where more detailed data were missing. (Koski Reports)

- 7) Oregon Fish Commission and district Annual Reports – Included an annual summary of fish liberation activity, but seldom provided detail of origin, location or size. Data from these reports were used primarily in the 1940s and late 1970s. (ann rpt)

Federal Hatchery Records

I contacted the Federal (USFWS) Hatcheries on the Columbia River (Spring Creek, Carson, Little White Salmon, and Clackamas), and in Idaho, and Montana who reportedly raised cutthroat trout in the early 1900’s and possibly shipped eggs or fry to Oregon. Log books and records from these hatcheries were examined by current hatchery managers and communicated via letter or telephone. I also located the egg shipment records from Yellowstone Hatchery 1914-1955. (Appendix D)

Local Long-Time Landowners

In consultation with Jeff Neal, ODFW John Day Assistant District Biologist, I contacted 9 landowners whose families have owned property within westslope cutthroat trout distribution (Table 1). The objective was to learn of anecdotal information pertaining to cutthroat trout and private stocking occurrences.

Retired Biologists

I interviewed Errol Claire, former ODFW John Day district biologist of thirty years (1959-1980’s), regarding past planting activity and his knowledge of the area.

**RESULTS**

Cutthroat Trout

Twenty-nine instances of cutthroat plantings or transfers were found for the John Day Basin. Two of these occurred in the mainstem and 27 occurred in the in the North Fork John Day watershed (Table 2). Of the two mainstem stocking events, one was conducted by

the Deardorff family who planted Yellowstone cutthroat trout in Deardorff Creek in 1912 (Claire, personal communication). During the early 1900's landowners shipped trout from the Yellowstone hatchery to enhance local angling opportunities. The second recorded event was in 1931 in Strawberry Lake where cutthroat trout of an unknown origin were stocked.

Cutthroat trout stocking events in the North Fork John Day basin occurred most frequently in high lakes, primarily Crawfish, Jump-off Joe, Lost and Olive lakes. The first known stocking occurred in 1895 when the Red Boy Mining Company brought in Yellowstone cutthroat trout to provide recreational opportunities for company miners (Claire, personal communication). Red Boy Mining Company put cutthroat trout in both Olive Lake and Upper Olive Lake. Stocks of cutthroat trout planted in these high lakes also include westslope (Twin Lakes WA), Lahontan (Mann Lake & Omak WA), and unidentified stocks from Idaho, Montana, California and Klamath (Table 2). The Idaho and Montana stocks were presumably westslope cutthroat trout but is undocumented.

The most notable transfer events in the North Fork John Day occurred in 1960 when cutthroat trout were moved from Deardorff Creek (mainstem) to South Fork Desolation and Clear Creek. One hundred fish were moved into each stream to purposely (re)establish a residual fishery suitable to the cold water and undisturbed habitat (Hewkin 1960; Errol Claire, personal communication).

### Rainbow Trout

Stocking of rainbow trout in the mainstem and North Fork John Day River basins was first recorded in 1925 and continued until 1997 in rivers and streams and is ongoing in some lakes and ponds (Table 3). The streams where rainbow trout were consistently stocked are Canyon Creek and the John Day River in the upper mainstem basin, and Camas Creek, Desolation Creek and North Fork John Day River in the North Fork Basin. Other streams with cutthroat trout were stocked once or twice with rainbow trout, most often in the 1920s or 1940s.

Of the ponds and lakes with stream outlets, Canyon Meadows Reservoir and Magone Lake were consistently stocked from 1964-1996 and 1940-present, respectively. In the North Fork John Day River, Olive lake and Pendland lake were stocked most frequently, from 1925-1985 and 1972-present, respectively.

Hatchery stocks of rainbow trout planted in the John Day Basin were primarily Roaring River, Cape Cod, Willamette and Oak Springs stocks (See appendix A for stocks of individual plantings). The Oak Springs stock originally came from Utah in 1923. In 1971 milt from a hatchery in Tacoma, Washington was mixed with this stock and the resulting stock was typically used for Eastern Oregon plantings (Kinunen & Moring 1976). Willamette Rainbow stock originated from McKenzie River rainbow. The Cape Cod stock came to Oregon from a commercial hatchery in Cape Cod, Massachusetts (Kinunen & Moring 1976). It is believed the Cape Cod hatchery originally obtained their rainbow trout from the McCloud Basin, California (Phil McKee, Fall River Hatchery, personal communication). The Roaring River stock was obtained from the W.S. Medow trout farm in Idaho in 1937, which originally acquired the parent brood from Utah (Kinunen & Moring 1976).

## Egg Transfers

In the 1920s and 30s Oregon received cutthroat trout eggs from outside the state. Early Oregon Game Commission annual reports reference receiving cutthroat trout eggs from Idaho, Montana, Washington and Wyoming. Research into records of hatcheries active during this period revealed many egg shipments delivered to federal and state hatcheries in Oregon. Yellowstone cutthroat trout eggs from Yellowstone Hatchery were received from 1912-1952 (Table 4, Appendix D). Records of ‘blackspotted trout’ eggs (presumably westslope cutthroat trout) shipped to Oregon exist from Anaconda hatchery between 1921-1938 (Table 5, Appendix D). In Washington State, Carson, Spring Creek, and Little White Salmon National Fish Hatcheries raised westslope cutthroat trout but only show records of plantings within Washington. Annual reports from Clackamas National Fish Hatchery show ‘Montana blackspotted trout’ were raised and distributed within Oregon (Appendix D). In all instances these records document the shipping and rearing of westslope and Yellowstone cutthroat trout in Oregon and the Pacific Northwest, and imply cutthroat trout were planted in Oregon, however specific locations of plantings were not identified.

### Landowners

Discussions with long-time landowners did not provide anecdotal evidence with enough detail to confirm or deny cutthroat trout introductions in the John Day Basin.

### **Discussion**

This investigation produced little evidence to support the hypothesis that humans introduced westslope cutthroat trout in the upper mainstem John Day River Basin. Only

two stocking events of cutthroat trout were documented in the basin, one of which involved the Yellowstone subspecies. The limited geographic range of these plantings make it unlikely that the current distribution of westslope cutthroat trout in the mainstem John Day River basin originated from either of these events.

Westslope cutthroat trout populations in the North Fork John Day may have originated from introduced fish. The current distribution does not extend much beyond that of the initial introduction sites. Plantings at Olive Lake and Jump-off Joe lake were frequent and numerous, making the establishment of a residual population plausible. The 1960 transfers of adult cutthroat trout from Deardorff Creek to Clear Creek and South Fork Desolation Creek were carried out with the intention of establishing a viable population. In the opinion of Errol Claire, westslope cutthroat trout in the North Fork John Day Watershed were established through these introductions.

Rainbow trout were planted in streams and ponds throughout the distribution of westslope cutthroat trout. Many of the stocking sites have received numerous plantings since 1925, particularly the John Day River, North Fork John Day River, Canyon Creek, and Canyon Meadows Reservoir. The development of a naturally-reproducing introduced rainbow trout population in these basins is not unrealistic, and may play a role in the degree of hybridization between westslope cutthroat trout and rainbow trout.

Findings of this investigation document plantings of cutthroat trout and rainbow trout in the upper basins of the John Day River. It is important to note that these findings represent only the clearly documented events. It is possible trout planting occurred without being recorded. Settlers were known to move fish among streams and basins. The goal of the long-time landowner interviews was to identify a few of these undocumented events. However, it quickly became evident that I was one or two generations too late. Many of the folks I spoke with were in their late 60's-70's and felt their parents or grandparents would have been a better source of information. Unfortunately most of those stories are lost to history. Also, in the early days of fish management 'milk can' trout and salmon plantings were probably more common than the records indicate. Thus, the reliability of these records is not absolute. We will never be certain whether or not a particular species was introduced by planting events based on stocking records alone.

Similarly, the data that do exist suffer many shortcomings. Of the records I was able to locate, gaps exist between 1912-1931, 1935-1939, and year 1947. Whether these records exist and are lost, or don't exist at all is unknown. The quality of data recording and storage varied over the last century. From the late 1800's to 1940 record keeping was sporadic and inconsistent. Stocking events were often recorded in narrative form and specific details regularly omitted. In the 1940's record keeping was more thorough and consistent. Hand written ledgers recorded most (though probably not all) fish liberation events. In 1978 ODFW developed the HMIS database which since has served as a fairly reliable source of hatchery fish liberation records. Unfortunately the database includes confusing and counterintuitive stock codes and lacks information regarding the specific parent stock.

Discrepancies were found between sources regarding the same stocking events. For example, the summaries of annual activity (Koski reports) did not always correspond to the actual records of individual stocking events (liberation report or cumulative stocking records)

for a particular year. This was the case for 1946, 1950 and ,1952-57. Also, for records between 1952 and 1977, numeric codes representing species and lot numbers (stocks) were difficult to decipher. The species codes between 1952 and 1954 eventually became self evident, but the lot numbers for this period were not decipherable. Between 1955 and 1977 lot numbers were represented with a four digit number. I located a document that defined only the first two digits for this code (appendix C). For the purpose of this investigation, I assumed these codes were correct because the translation is logical and consistent with following years. Finally, numerical codes for hatcheries changed when the Fish and Game Commissions merged. Fortunately two years later the hatchery codes were changed again to logical alphabetical codes.

This investigation was limited in scope. Much more time and effort could be spent locating and reading annual reports, investigating hatchery records, and exploring archives. However such effort would likely not prove fruitful. Due to the poor quality of historic records and undocumented stocking events, a certain and definitive conclusion is not possible.
