OELA materials grants are intended to help teachers gain the resources and/or training for effective instruction of English language learners, particularly in the areas of reading, math and science, and share the information with their colleagues. Please be as specific as possible in outlining the details of how you intend to use the money from this stipend and how your purpose forwards the stated goal. The project team will evaluate all requests, but only up to approximately \$750 will be funded for the district.

You will be responsible for submitting a final report including receipts and doing a presentation to local teachers on how the money has been spent and on the pedagogical purposes. A final report will be due on May 31, 2004.
