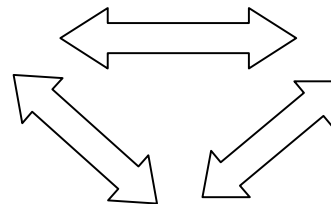
Mission: Provide the knowledge and education necessary for managing vegetation and other resources on rangelands
