## **Student Involvement Overview:**

## **Application Process:**

To apply for a Student Involvement Student Staff position, submit the following by the application deadline (see Recruitment and Selection Process Timeline for more information):

- Resume and cover letter addressing your related work, volunteer, and/or leadership experience
- An essay (no more than 2 pages) addressing the following three topics:
  - Describe your experience working with diverse groups and/or traditionally underrepresented students.
  - If you were going to make T-E-A-M an acronym to describe teamwork, what words would you use? How do these words apply to your leadership personality?
  - What can you contribute towards involvement and leadership development opportunities on the OSU campus?
- Completed OSU General Activities Eligibility Form
